



Facts at a Glance

Mission: The mission of Community Hospice Foundation is to advance philanthropy to enable Community Hospice of Northeast Florida to fulfill its mission and vision of care, research and education.

Areas of Support: In fulfillment of its mission, the sole purpose of Community Hospice Foundation is to generate philanthropic and community support for Community Hospice of Northeast Florida. Serving the five-county area of Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau and St. Johns counties, Community Hospice daily cares for nearly 1,200 adults and children and their families.

Funds raised through Community Hospice Foundation support the following:

- Patient Care that is unfunded or under-funded by insurance reimbursement
- Emergency assistance for patients and patient families with financial need
- Equipment for patient care
- Facilities and endowment
- Unfunded programs of Community Hospice, including the following:
 - Community PedsCare®** – hospice and palliative care for children with life-threatening and life-limiting conditions and their families
 - Charles M. Neviasser Educational Institute** – end-of-life education for professionals, community outreach and education on end-of-life issues, grief and bereavement counseling and services
